Birds – Botany - Sea Life - History

Enjoy the company of other nature enthusiasts as you experience the natural wonders and history of Western Australia's Abrolhos Islands

The Houtman Abrolhos is an archipelago of 108 islands and rocks located about 80 km off the mid- west coast of Western Australia. The islands are renowned for their extensive array of marine life and bloody history.

They are also home for many tropical seabirds and a diverse array of wildlife.

As well as time spent ashore there will be plenty of time to snorkel in the clear waters where you may also hopefully come across bottle-nosed dolphins and sea lions.

Some of the birds found on the islands include the common and lesser noddys, roseate, sooty and bridled terns, shearwaters, osprey, sea eagles, cormorants, storm petrels and the red tailed tropic bird.

Your vessel and home for the time spent on the islands is the *Eco Abrolhos*, one of the largest vessels working out of Geraldton. At 35 metres she can accommodate 38 passengers in twin share cabins with en-suites. She is an eminently stable, reliable and comfortable platform to enjoy the wonders of the Abrolhos Islands. All accommodation areas, as well as other internal areas in the vessel, are fully air conditioned.

The sea crossing to the islands can be rough and lasts around 2 1/2 hours. Participants should note that landings may entail embarking and disembarking from inflatable vessels or dinghies.

Itinerary

Day 1 Perth to Geraldton

Depart Perth for Geraldton at 07.00hrs. Today's drive will take us through the coastal sand plains as we head north to Geraldton. Our goal is to get into Geraldton early enough to be able to visit the Maritime Museum which has an excellent display about the islands and their history.

The next four days will be spent looking at the birds, marine wildlife and historical sites on the Wallabi, Easter and Pelsaert group of islands.

After breakfast we leave Geraldton and head south to Perth. We will travel via the Mount Lesueur National Park or the Pinnacles Desert and should arrive back in Perth late afternoon.

However in general comfortable casual clothing is recommended. Light shirts and T-shirts during the day and warmer shirts for the evenings. A light Spray Jacket is also recommended.
